Refreshing of existing East-West cycle route in High Wycombe

Buckinghamshire Council has been awarded £514,000 by the Department for Transport for a programme of active travel schemes across the County. These schemes are designed to help people to make local journeys on foot or by bike for travelling to work, schools, shopping and leisure activities. Recent months have seen increased levels of cycling and walking, and the Council has received many requests for measures to support these changing travel patterns.

Following discussions with local Councillors, it has been agreed to refresh and upgrade the existing East-West cycle route in High Wycombe. This includes additional wayfinding signs, improved accessibility, refreshing of existing markings and installation of solar studs through the park near Millbrook Combined School, through Lilys Walk and along the path by the Rye (the south side of The Dyke).

Subject to weather conditions, it is hoped to commence works in mid-March and it is anticipated this will take no longer than one week. This letter is to notify you in advance prior to works taking place. The existing route which will be refreshed goes from Millbrook Combined School, along Abercromby Avenue, along Desborough Road, through Lilys Walk, along the south side of the Dyke and then continues along Keep Hill Road, along Bassetsbury Lane to Kingsmead Road.
