

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

CYCLE TRACKS ACT 1984

CYCLE TRACKS ORDER 2021

On 7 February 2024 Buckinghamshire Council confirmed the above Order, without modification, made under Section 3 of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to designate a length of Public Footpath No. 33, Weston Turville from point A on the Order map at SP8465-1319 south for approximately 632 metres to point B at SP8471-1257 as shown by a bold broken black line and having a width of 3 metres, as shared use cycle track with a right of way for pedal cycles and on foot.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Reception, Buckinghamshire Council, Walton Street Offices, Walton Street, Aylesbury, HP20 1UA and at Aylesbury Library, Walton Street, Aylesbury, HP20 1UU during normal opening hours. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the Council at a cost of £5.00 by writing to the Definitive Map Team, Buckinghamshire Council, Walton Street Offices, Walton Street, Aylesbury, HP20 1UA or email row@buckinghamshire.gov.uk.

The Order comes into force on 27 March 2024 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any Regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under subsection 6 of Section 3 of the Act, within six weeks from 28 February 2024 make an application to the High Court.
